



## CITY CENTER









San Francisco City Center, located along the bustling Geary Boulevard corridor, is a 120,000 SF shopping destination anchored by Target, PetSmart, Bank of America, and Whole Foods (pending). The center attracts visitors from the greater San Francisco Bay Area, and services surrounding neighborhoods such as The Richmond, Laurel Heights, Presidio Heights, and Pacific Heights. There are five dedicated parking lots offering ample parking for those traveling by car, while the 38/38Rapid line MUNI station, which crosses the entire city, is adjacent for those using public transportation. Notable neighbors include The Fillmore District, Haight-Ashbury, The Painted Ladies, Golden Gate Park, University of San Francisco, and UCSF Medical Center.
